— Matthew 6:9

God is not a distant observer.

He is a loving Father who desires a relationship with His children.

Four Characteristics of God

Throughout Scripture, God consistently reveals His character.

Four of His most recognizable attributes are:

Love

God's love is unconditional, sacrificial, and eternal.

His love is not based upon our performance.

His love is based upon His nature.

"God is love."

— 1 John 4:8

Grace

Grace is God's unearned favor.

It is receiving what we could never earn and do not deserve.

Salvation itself is a gift of grace.

"For by grace you have been saved through faith."

— Ephesians 2:8

Truth

God never changes.

His truth remains constant regardless of culture, circumstances, or opinions.

His Word provides direction, wisdom, and guidance.

"Your Word is truth."

— John 17:17

Faithfulness

God always keeps His promises.

What He begins, He completes.

What He says, He fulfills.

His faithfulness remains steady even when ours does not.

"Great is Your faithfulness."

— Lamentations 3:23

Why Jesus Matters

If we want to know what God is like, we look to Jesus Christ.

Jesus is the perfect revelation of the Father.

He demonstrated:

- Love to the broken
- Grace to sinners
- Truth without compromise
- Faithfulness to the Father's will

Jesus did not merely teach about God.

Jesus revealed God.

"He who has seen Me has seen the Father."

— John 14:9

What This Means For You

Because God is love, you are loved.

Because God is gracious, you can be forgiven.

Because God is truthful, you can trust Him.

Because God is faithful, you can depend upon Him.

No matter your past.
