I learned that God's grace is greater than my failures.

I learned that His plans are better than my plans.

I learned that true peace is found not in circumstances but in Christ.

Since giving my life to Jesus, I have developed a deep love for God's Word and continue to discover new truths about His character, promises, and faithfulness every day.

One lesson stands above all the others.

The enemy wants us to believe that our failures define us.

Jesus tells us something entirely different.

Through His death and resurrection, forgiveness is available to every person who places their faith in Him. When we confess our sins and turn back to God, His grace restores us.

That truth gave birth to the ministry called Not1Point.

The message is simple:
